According to the Fee Structure prescribed for the NRI category seats in AFRC Order no. FRC 50/25/NURSING/AMCSFNCK/PNCMAK dated 10/07/2025, the Annual Tuition Fees payable by students being admitted under the NRI category seats is Rs.1,04,500/- per year. All other fees including special fees as detailed above of this prospectus are applicable to students admitted under the NRI category too. The payment of tuition and special fee should only through online payment/cheque/DD/RTGS/IMPS etc.

Candidates who express their intention not to pursue studies in the Nursing college before the last date fixed for closure of admissions will be eligible for refund of the 1<sup>st</sup> year tuition fee and other fees except admission fee. They will be eligible to get back their original certificates handed over to the college at the time of admission. In the case of students who leave the college midway, the right of the management for liquidated images, if any, from such students will be determined by the competent “Civil court”.

## **ADMISSION**

### **Eligibility for admission**

1. Out of the sanctioned seat, 50% is reserved for government quota and 50% for management quota, within which 15% is reserved for NRI quota.
2. The candidate for admission to B.Sc nursing degree course should have passed the plus two course of the Kerala State Higher Secondary Education Board with Physics, Chemistry and Biology as optional subjects and English and should have obtained 50% of marks on these subjects put together or its equivalent examination approved by the Kerala University of Health Sciences. The due concessions in the minimum percentage of marks for SC/ST candidates are as per university rules.
3. The minimum age for admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year of admission (As per University norms)
4. The candidate shall be medically fit

## **DURATION**

Duration of the program shall be four years (Eight semesters). Integrated practice is incorporated with respective practical hours in each semester from Semester I to VII. Semester VIII is the period of internship intended for intensive practicum/residency posting.

5. Affidavit by the sponsor on Stamp paper worth Rs.200 attested by the notary
6. Relationship Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahasildar (\*Relationship with the sponsor should comply the Government order GO (MS) No.193/2013/H&FWD dtd.22.05.2013 & KUHS Order No.2836/ACB/kuhs/2014,dated 12.06.2014)

## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE**

### **1. Issue of online application form**

Candidate seeking admission to the course at Parabrahma College of Nursing can fill the application in the college website [www.parabrahmacon.org](http://www.parabrahmacon.org) along with payment of Rs.1000/-by bank transfer to the college account. The application fees once paid is not refundable. No application is considered final without payment of application fees.

### **2. Submission of application form**

- Application form should be filled carefully in block letters and without any ambiguity in the online portal.
- Photographs should be properly uploaded wherever necessary
- No column in the application form should be left unfilled
- If no entry is applicable in a particular column, please fill NA/NIL as the case may be
- Application must be e-signed by the candidates
- Incomplete applications and those received after the closing date will not be entertained.
- Attach copies of all documents properly with the application
- The last date of application is 20/08/2026.
- The declaration of the candidate, as to the details provided in the application are true to the best of my knowledge, should be included in the online application form.

### **NOTE:**

- Applications not accompanied by documents in proof of claims made therein will be summarily rejected without further intimation.
- At the of interview and admission, the candidate should produce all the original certificate of the copies already submitted along with application and a medical fitness certificate issued by a medical practitioner.
- Candidates are advised to keep sufficient attested copies of certificate with them for future use.

## **ADMISSION FOR NRI QUOTA SEATS**

According to GO (MS) No. 243/2014/H&FWD dated 06.08.2014, “An applicant who depends upon his/her Father/ Mother/ Brother and sisters (inclusive of first cousins)/ Husband/ wife/ Brothers and Sisters (inclusive of first cousins) of Father or Mother/ Half Brother/ Half sister/ Adopted Father or Adopted Mother who is working abroad” will only be eligible to apply in the NRI category seats. The following documents in original to prove the NRI status of the sponsor and his/her relationship with the applicant shall be submitted at the time of admission.

- 1) Sponsorship Certificate
- 2) The Indian Embassy attested copy of the relevant page of the passport where Employment Visa is stamped
- 3) Employment certificate duly attested by the Indian Embassy
- 4) Relationship Certificate from the village Officer /Tahasildar
- 5) Sworn affidavit in Rs. 200/-stamp paper attested by notary

### ***Preparation of merit list***

- 1) Merit list: merit list of eligible candidates will be prepared by the college on the basis of marks obtained in the optional subjects (Physics+ Chemistry+ Biology and English) for the qualifying examination
- 2) Resolution of ties while ranking: in case of tie in the total marks, the marks in biology will count. If there is still a tie, then the marks in chemistry and physics will count. If a tie still exists, the age of the candidate will be taken into account, the elder will be preferred to the younger.
- 3) Validity of the merit list: the published merit list will be valid till 30/09/2024 or the date up to which the merit lists shall be kept alive in terms of instruction/ direction of competent authority.

## **CURRICULUM**

The Parabrahma College of Nursing follows the Curriculum prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences, Thrissur.

### **STUDENTS ACTIVITIES**

Students are expected to participate in all the activities organized by the college. Students are encouraged to become members of the Student Nurses Association. The Student Nurses Association will provide a means of personal and professional development for the nursing student.

To use leisure time creatively and effectively, they are provided with facilities for indoor and outdoor games.

Educational trips are arranged for the students every year. Educational trips will be charged during the course and students will have to bear the full expense of the trip. Free conveyance may be available for short distance.

### **HOSTEL**

- Hostel facilities will be provided to the girls as required.
- Rooms are provided with furniture. Each student must bring bedding / mattress, a pillow, 4 bed sheets, 2 pillow covers, an umbrella and a watch with a second hand.
- They should not bring any valuable jewelry. The college will not take any responsibility for loss or theft.

- Food will be provided in the hostel. The charges for each month will be based on dividing system. Boarding charges must be paid at the beginning of the academic year.
- Parents and students are required to read and sign the rules of the hostel formed by the management. The same will be given to the student at the time of selection.

## **VACATION AND HOLIDAYS**

Vacation and Holidays will be available as per syllabus and university norms.

## **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS**

- a) Ragging: ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the college. Hence any student who indulges any form of ragging will be subjected to penal action as per provisions of law. Also the student will be expelled from the college as detailed in the law concerned and as per the Honourable Supreme Court of India direction in this regard.
- b) Use of mobile phones: use of mobile phone by students is not allowed in the college campus and clinical areas. Any violation of this prohibition will lead to stringent disciplinary action by the college authorities.

## **DRESS CODE**
